

## Sample Daily Schedule

Activities for each age group will be planned by the teaching staff keeping the developmental age of the students in mind.

- 9:15-10:15 Atelier Classroom "Atelier" means "art studio" or "workshop" in French. A Reggio Emilia Atelier is a welcoming and inspiring place offering a wide variety of natural and man-made materials for artistic expression where large group activities including Block Building, Housekeeping, Art, Math/Science, Sensory Tables (sand, water, playdough, clay, light) are introduced to the children.
- 10:15-11:15 Classroom (small group activities) including Morning Prayer, Pledge of Allegiance,

  Morning Meeting, Discussion of Days activities and schedule. Other classroom activities

  may include music and movement, story time, literacy activities, picture stories, story

  dictation, art, math, science, social studies, investigation and closing meeting.
- 11:15-12:15 Outdoor play, Nature walks and studies, field activities including running games, soccer, and team sports. Scientific investigations are also done through our outdoor garden area.

Children will also be served a daily snack.

Children who stay until 1:15 will bring and eat their lunch together with their classmates.

It is especially important to remember that when working with preschool children that schedules remain flexible and may change depending on the children's attention span or interest.
